the following resolution is adopted:

ADOPTING THE 2008 SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT
FOR THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE
DELETING INTERLAKEN/COLLEGE ROAD

The Santa Cruz Local Agency Formation Commission (the "Commission") does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. In accordance with Government Code Section 56425(g), the Commission has initiated a periodic review of the Sphere of Influence of the City of Watsonville.
2. In accordance with Government Code Section 56430, the Commission has previously completed the Countywide Service Review, which includes an evaluation of public services in Watsonville and its vicinity.
3. In accordance with Government Code Section 56425 et seq., the Commission received a report and recommendation from its staff addressing the City of Watsonville's Sphere of Influence.
4. The Commission's Executive Officer gave notice of a public hearing by this Commission upon this sphere of influence amendment in the form and manner prescribed by law.
5. The Commission held its public hearing on this matter on March 5, 2008; and at the hearing the Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections, and evidence that were presented.
6. Compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act has been met by a categorical exemption pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15320—organizational changes that do not change the geographical area in which previously existing powers are exercised.
7. The Commission hereby amends the Sphere of Influence for the City of Watsonville to exclude the Interlaken and College Road areas as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto.

8. The Commission adopts the Sphere of Influence Statement of Determinations listed in Exhibit B attached hereto.
